**ENTRIES CLOSE: 8:00PM WEDNESDAY APRIL 21, 2010** after which time entries cannot be accepted cancelled or changed except as allowed by the American Kennel Club Rules. **Make all checks payable to Obedience Training Club of Chugiak Inc. or OTCC; Make all Canadian checks and money orders payable in US funds.**

Refund of 1/2 of entry fee will be refunded for bitches that come into season with veterinarian verification.

**Notice to Exhibitors:** A recording fee of 50 cents and event service fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show Obedience trial or tracking test. Fees are to be collected by the show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only : the event service fee is collected on each entry (American Kennel Club rules Chapter 11 Section 2).

### General Information and Rules & Additional rules

Only dogs eligible to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts. Puppies under the age of six months cannot be entered and will not be allowed on the show grounds.

No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

To be an acceptable entry an entry must be submitted with required entry fee on an official American Kennel club entry form. Entries submitted in the form of telegrams, by the telephone, or by email cannot be accepted. No dogs wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class except as allowed by American Kennel Club rules.

Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms regardless of who may make such errors.

Dogs need to be at the show only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging .

There shall be no drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises. All dogs shall be kept on leash or shall be restrained in a crate ex-pen or other acceptable enclosure.

(except when in the obedience ring) The welfare of an exhibitors child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor and will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in the show or trials. Dogs who have earned a title before a trial may be moved up to the next class . A written request must be made with the trial secretary prior to 8:30 am on the day of judging. Instructions for entering dogs turn to the classification and select class or classes for which your dog is eligible then fill in the entry form completely **to include jump heights**. Please type or print plainly in ink on entry form as the club assumes no liability for wrong information

### **Pre Novice Non Regular Obedience Class**

**PRE-NOVICE CLASS.** The Pre-Novice Class shall be for dogs that have not received a third qualifying score in a Novice class prior to the closing of the trial. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class; however, if a person has handled more than one dog in the first four exercises, that person must provide a handler for the additional dog in the group exercises. All exercises will be scored as in the Novice class, except the dogs will perform all exercises on leash, which should be 6 feet in length. The exercises include: heel on leash (45), figure eight (25), stand for examination (30), recall (40), long sit (30) and long down (30).

### **Special Event Class**

#### **Versatile Veterans Non Regular Obedience Class**

Versatile Veterans Class shall be for dogs that are at least seven (7) years of age. The dog may NOT compete in this class if it is also entered in the regular open or utility classes. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. There will be no group exercises in this class. Dogs entered in this class are to jump at the nearest higher multiple of 2 to half of the dog's height at the withers. "All dogs must perform the heel free & figure 8 exercise as described in the regular open class (25 points). The class will include six exercises from the Open & Utility regular classes (Drop on Recall, Retrieve on the Flat, Retrieve over the High Jump, Scent Discrimination, Directed Retrieve, Directed Jumping). The dog must perform five of the six exercises, with the handler indicating which exercise will be excluded at the time that the armband is picked up during check-in. The Open/Utility exercises will be performed as in the regular classes, with each exercise being worth 35 points. Total points for the class will be 200."

3. Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto AK-1 N/GLENN HWY/INTERSTATE A1 N. 15.6 mi
4. Take the S. BIRCHWOOD exit. 0.3 mi
5. Turn RIGHT onto S BIRCHWOOD LOOP RD. 0.6 mi
6. Turn LEFT onto OLD GLENN HWY. 2.1 mi
7. 18606 OLD GLENN HWY is on the LEFT.
