Entry Fee: \$40.00 (including \$0.50 AKC recording fee and \$3.00 AKC Event service fee)

A qualifying certificate must accompany this entry. No electronic entries will be available for this test.

Notice to Exhibitors: A recording fee of 50 cents and event service fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show Obedience trial or tracking test. Fees are to be collected by the show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show or trial the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only : the event service fee is collected on each entry (American Kennel Club rules Chapter 11 Section 2)

Notice: The club may cancel the event in the case of extreme weather conditions. No entry fees will be refunded if the show is cancelled due to circumstances that are beyond the control of the club such as weather or other acts of god or civil disobedience.

ENTRIES CLOSE: 8:00PM WEDNESDAY APRIL 21, 2010

After which time no entries may be accepted, changed or cancelled except as allowed by the American Kennel Club rules.

Should such acknowledgements not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time please notify the Trial Secretary at the listed address phone or email (please note "OTCC trials" in the subject line for email)

Drawing for entries will be held at 6:30pm Thursday April 22, 2010 at the OTCC facility located at 18606 Old Glenn Highway, Chugiak, AK 99567.

All dogs must be on the tracking test area by 9:00am Friday May 7, 2010 at which time there will be a drawing for post time for each dog.

This tracking dog test will be open at 7:00am Judging will start promptly at 9:30 am. The site will be closed 30 minutes after the completion of the last dogs run or no later than 5pm on the day of the test.

This tracking dog test shall be for dogs not less than six months of age and must be judged by two judges. If the dog has not "passed" an AKC Tracking Test there must be filed with the entry form an original written statement dated within one year and signed by a person who has been approved by the AKC to judge tracking tests, certifying that the dog is considered by him / her to be ready for such a test. Written permission to waive or modify the requirement may be granted by the American Kennel Club in unusual circumstances. Tracking tests are open to all dogs that are otherwise eligible under these regulations.

Note Bitches in season may participate, Any exhibitor who enters a bitch in this tracking test which shall come in season needs to notify the Test Secretary and Judges prior to the drawing for tracks. The last track (s) to be laid shall be reserved for bitches in season. If there is more than one bitch in season a second draw will be held for these bitches run order.

Acknowledgments may be sent via email if an email address is provided.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent disqualified excused by the judge or veterinarian or barred from competition by actions of the trial committee or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riots civil disturbances or other acts beyond control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete this trial no refund of entry fee will be made.

Additional rules

Only dogs eligible to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts. Puppies under the age of six months cannot be entered and will not be allowed on the show grounds. No unentered dogs will be allowed in the track area.

No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

To be an acceptable entry an entry must be submitted with required entry fee on an official American Kennel club entry form. Entries submitted in the form of telegrams, by the telephone, or by email cannot be accepted. No dogs wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class except as allowed by American Kennel Club rules.

Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms regardless of who may make such errors.

Dogs need to be at the show only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging .

There shall be no drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises. All dogs shall be kept on leash except when in the obedience ring. or shall be restrained in a crate ex-pen or other acceptable enclosure. the welfare of an exhibitors child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor and will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in the show or trials. Dogs who have earned a title before a trial may be moved up to the next class . A written request must be made with the trial secretary prior to 8:30 am on the day of judging.

Instructions for entering dogs turn to the classification and select class or classes for which your dog is eligible then fill in the entry form completely to include jump heights. Complete class descriptions can be found in the American Kennel Club rule and regulations on **the AKC web site www.akc.org**

1. Start out going EAST on E PALMER-WASILLA HWY / W EVERGREEN AVE toward S ELLEN ST. Continue to follow W EVERGREEN AVE. go 0.2 mi total 0.2 mi
2. Turn LEFT onto S GLENN HWY / AK-1 S / INTERSTATE A1 N. go 0.5 mi total 0.8 mi
3. Turn RIGHT onto W ARCTIC AVE. go 0.8 mi total 1.5 mi
4. W ARCTIC AVE becomes N OLD GLENN HWY. go 1.5 mi total 3.0 mi
5. Turn LEFT onto E CLARK WOLVERINE RD. go 0.7 mi total 3.8 mi
6. Turn LEFT to stay on E CLARK WOLVERINE RD. go 0.8 mi total 4.6 mi
7. Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto N CLARK-WOLVERINE RD. go 1.4 mi total 6.0 mi
8. Turn LEFT onto N WOLVERINE RD. go 1.6 m total 7.6 mi
9. N WOLVERINE RD. go 0.0 mi total 7.6 mi

3. Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto AK-1 N/GLENN HWY/INTERSTATE A1 N. 15.6 mi
4. Take the S. BIRCHWOOD exit. 0.3 mi
5. Turn RIGHT onto S BIRCHWOOD LOOP RD. 0.6 mi
6. Turn LEFT onto OLD GLENN HWY. 2.1 mi
7. 18606 OLD GLENN HWY is on the LEFT.
