**Online vs. Paper Entry Primary Limits**

OTCC is accepting online entries through Dog Events Online. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows:

Online Entries: 50%: Paper entries: 50%.

If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour period, OTCC reserves the right to adjust the limits.

**Maximum entries per envelope**

A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.

**Jump Height Cards:** All dogs (except those running at 24" and 26" and dogs with AKC jump height cards) **MUST** be measured by the judge before their **first** run for that trial and the measurement will only be effective for that set of trials. If you have a valid AKC jump height card, ***please attach a copy of it to your entry.*** If your dog is measured into a taller jump class, he must be moved up into it at the trial. ***If your dog is measured down, he cannot move into a lower jump class!*** **Measuring will take place at 8 AM, 16 and 17 June 2007.**

If there is an AKC Agility Rep at the trial, all dogs entered will need to be measured for their permanent AKC jump card. This includes dogs jumping at the 24" & 25" heights.

**Move-Ups:** Move up to a higher class will be allowed if received by the Trial Secretary in writing by **11 June 2007, 6:00pm AST**. No move-ups will be accepted after that date and time. E-mail is acceptable [jacqfab@gci.net](mailto:jacqfab@gci.net). Fax is acceptable (907) 688-1544. Move-ups for Sunday will be allowed if received by the trial secretary in writing **within 30 minutes** of release of the final run scores on Saturday. No move ups will be accepted after that time.

**Walk Throughs and Warm ups:** Handlers in all classes will be permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class. A warm up area consisting of a single regulation agility jump will be provided.

**Classes:** It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter the dog in the correct class. The trial secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups) after the closing date of the trial. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check in with the gate steward and be at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The Judge is not obligated to wait for any exhibitor.

**Awards:** Ribbons will be awarded for placements and qualifying scores. Each qualifying score ribbon shall be dark green in color will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score.

First, second, third, or fourth place ribbons shall be the following colors:

- First Place .....Blue
- Second Place.....Red
- Third Place.....Yellow
- Fourth Place .....White

**Trophies:** First place in each class and jump height will be awarded a dog toy (Toy of \$1-3 value). MACH and Titling ribbons will be awarded.

**Catalogues:** In order to keep costs down, we are asking those interested in catalogues to pre-pay at the rate of \$7.00 each. A limited number of catalogs will be available for purchase at the trial. See order form for pre-order information. (see page 8)

**Obstacles:** Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition (Sep. 2006) of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials with the A-frame (9' sides), Dogwalk (12' planks).

**Event Cancellation:** If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry will be made. The well being of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance, and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry will be made.

### **Important Information for Exhibitors:**

Training on Grounds: Chapter 4, Section 15 of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials state, "No agility obstacle training is allowed on the show grounds except for the use of the warm-up jump." The "grounds" include the entire Chugiak Benefit Association facility, parking lots, buildings, RV/motor home parking area, etc.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone, fax, or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Overnight mail entries should have the "no signatures" box checked. Entries not on an AKC form (that includes the disclaimer form on the back) are not acceptable. Please make sure only AKC recognized prefixes and suffixes are used on all entries.

Confirmation of entries will be e-mailed within a day or so of receipt as they are entered into the computer. Final entry confirmation and judging schedule will be e-mailed or sent to the entry address as soon as possible after the closing date. If you have not received confirmation at least 7 days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

All dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the AKC, or that have Limited Registration or ILP, are eligible to enter this trial. Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible to participate. Blind, lame, or aggressive dogs, and bitches in season are ineligible to compete.

Dogs may wear a flat buckle or rolled leather collar. There shall be no attachments or tags, hanging or otherwise allowed. The dog may run without a collar. Dogs must be on leash at all times, except when in the ring or at the practice jump.

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date with one exception. Handlers with bitches who come into heat after the closing date and before or during the trial, may receive a refund of half the entry fee with written notice given to the trial chairman. If the dog/handler are dismissed from the competition, regardless of the reason, there will be no refund.

Owners or handlers entering dogs in a trial do so at their own risk and agree to assume responsibility for any damage caused by them, or by their dogs. They also agree to abide by the Rules of the American Kennel Club and these Regulations.

There will be an exercise area provided for the dogs. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to take care of their dogs and to clean any area(s) soiled by their dogs outside of this area.

Exhibitors will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and setup areas.

All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the Obedience Training Club of Chugiak, Inc. or its members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor, who must exercise control and restraint over the child while the child is on the show premises. Failure to do so will result in action by the Trial Committee.

A Trial Committee may decline any entries or may remove any dog from its event for cause, but in each such instance shall file good and sufficient reasons for doing so with the American Kennel Club.

A dog that in the opinion of the judge attacks any person in the ring, shall be disqualified.

The judge will excuse a dog that attacks another dog in the ring or if the judge witnesses a dog attack another dog while entering or exiting the ring.

## **CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:**

**Regular Standard:** Novice A & B, Open, Excellent A & B  
Standard agility classes include obstacles, tunnels, jumps, and weave poles.

**Regular Jumpers With Weaves:** Novice A & B, Open, Excellent A & B  
JWW classes include tunnels, jumps, and weave poles.

**Preferred Classes:** Same divisions as Standard and JWW (Preferred Novice is not broken down into A & B divisions). The Preferred Class is open to any dog eligible to enter in an agility trial, as defined by AKC "Regulations for Agility Trials".

The handler may choose to enter the Preferred Class in lieu of entering the Regular Standard or Regular JWW classes at any trial. The dog must be entered **only** in the Preferred or Regular Classes, with no crossover between them allowed at the same set of trials.

**Novice:** Novice A is for handlers and dogs that have never acquired an AKC agility title. Novice B is for dogs that have acquired any AKC novice title (either NA or NJ) or persons who have handled a dog to an AKC agility title or for agility judges.

**Open:** For dogs that have acquired the Novice or Open titles but have not earned a qualifying score in the Excellent class.

**Excellent A:** For dogs that have acquired the Open title but have not completed the Excellent title.

**Excellent B:** For dogs that have acquired the Excellent title.

**Height divisions-** Regular Classes-dog measured at the withers:

8" –for dogs 10" and under  
12"-for dogs 14" and under  
16"-for dogs 18" and under  
20"-for dogs 22" and under  
24"-for dogs over 22"  
26" - at the owner's discretion

**Height divisions-** Preferred Classes

4" – for dogs 10" and under  
8" - for dogs 14" and under  
12"- for dogs 18" and under  
16"- for dogs 22" and under  
20"- for dogs over 22"

## **OVERNIGHT RV PARKING**

Overnight RV parking is available, limited to 10, requires advanced reservations with fees. There are no hookups or gray water facilities.

RV's must be totally self-contained.

For day parking of RV's, length is limited to 25' or less.

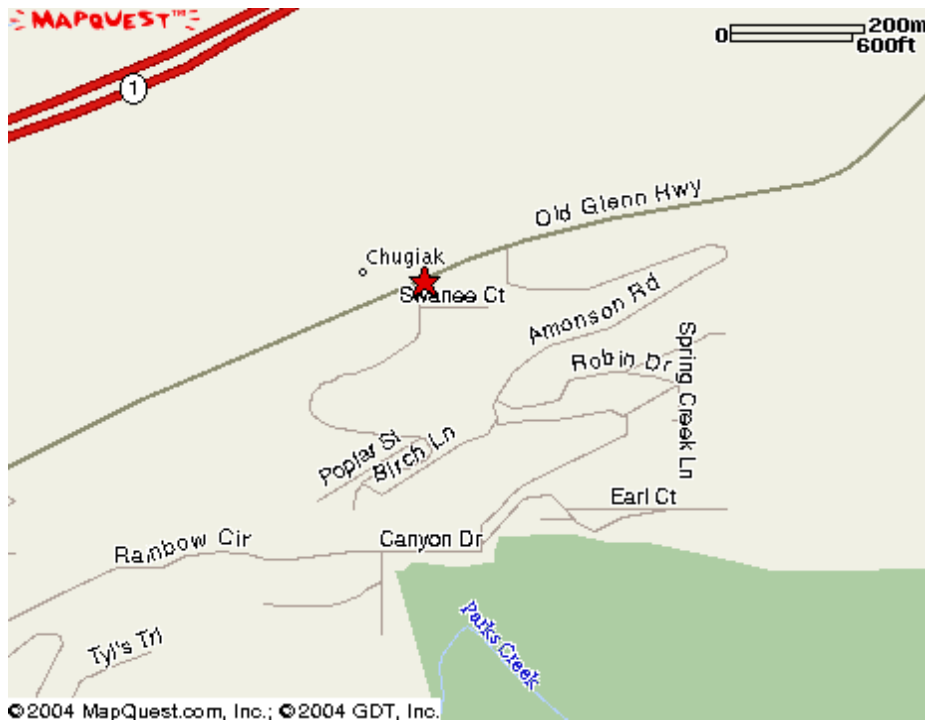

**From Fairbanks:** AK-3/GEORGE PARKS HWY/PARKS HWY. Continue to follow AK-3/GEORGE PARKS HWY. 318.5 miles. Take AK-1 S/GLENN HWY S. 14.4 miles. Take the South Birchwood Exit and then turn LEFT onto BIRCHWOOD LOOP RD. 0.3 miles. Turn RIGHT onto OLD GLENN HWY. 0.9 miles. End at 18606 Old Glenn Hwy Chugiak AK

**From Anchorage:** AK-1 N, Glen Hwy. 14.8 miles. Turn RIGHT onto N EAGLE RIVER ACCESS RD. Turn LEFT onto OLD GLENN HWY. 4.3 miles then end at 18606 Old Glenn Hwy Chugiak AK

**FROM Soldotna/Kenai:** Start out going East on E REDOUBT AVE toward KENAI SPUR HWY. Turn LEFT onto AK-1/STERLING HWY. Continue to follow AK-1. Turn RIGHT onto AK-1 N/SEWARD HWY N.
